Family Tradition:

My dad, Montie died July 4, 2026. He was 84 years old. Being a schoolteacher and history buff, he would have liked that he died on the same day as three US Presidents and on



America's 250th birthday. He was one of the main reasons that I joined the military. Many servicemembers join the military following in the footsteps of a parent or grandparent. Who influenced you to join?

My dad served honorably in the US Army from 1960 to 1963. He was a Military Policeman (MP) in the 709th Police Battalion stationed first in Scheinfurt and then Bamberg, Germany. Growing up, I heard stories about the Cold War, his off-post patrols and all his adventures with his two friends Tommy and Robert. One story that I will share is from his time in boot camp. He was ordered to "field day" an area outside. He was cleaning but not picking up any of the cigarette butts. When asked by his Drill Sergeant why, he responded, "I don't smoke." Well, you can image what happened. Needless to say, that life lesson stuck and my dad taught it to all his children.

In early 2000, I travelled to Germany with my dad and had opportunity to see a free, unified Germany visiting locations where my dad worked years ago. He cried when he saw Checkpoint Charlie as a museum. The last time he saw it, it was a working checkpoint separating West Berlin from East Berlin. My dad's service, along with the selfless sacrifice of thousands of other veterans, was the reason tyranny was stopped and freedom won the day.

One of my favorite pictures of my dad is from the summer when he built the house in which I was raised.

He is wearing jeans and a white Tee-shirt with his boot up on the fence in our backyard. Next to him flies the American flag. The photo was taken the day he built the fence and mounted the flag. When I look at this picture, I am reminded of the qualities of not only a good service member but the qualities of a loving husband and a wonderful dad. Let me share just three of those qualities.

First, hard work done well. To achieve mastery in any discipline – carpentry, building a fence, cleaning – a person must have a high attention to detail, a disciplined focus and be consistent. Pick up cigarette butts even if you don't smoke. Second, selfless sacrifice and loyalty. Show up. Listen well. Be loyal. Help friends. Do all this without expecting something in return. Finally, share your story. My dad told his story to a stubborn teenager who thought he knew it all. He talked when I did not listen. He loved when I pushed away. That love eventually won the day.

My dad fulfilled his obligations to God and country.

He chose and demonstrated every day a lifelong dedication and commitment to my mom and his family. His behavior consistently displayed his faith and his values. I am the

man I am today because my dad poured into me.

I was listening and I saw his actions. My dad was not perfect, but he was forgiven of all his sins by Jesus Christ, his Lord and Savior. I mourn my dad, but I have hope in the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Until I see my dad again in heaven, I recommit to pass on his legacy to my family and all who I encounter. If your dad is still alive, give him a call.

Board of Elders (BoE) August 2026 Update:

At the June 7, 2026 Voters' Assembly meeting Prince of Peace Lutheran Church – LCMS (PoP) members elected their **Elder Team**:

Elder-A: Brian Houck, **Elder-B:** Bill Leveille and **Elder C**-Ryan Light are continuing elders. Terms ending June 2027. Then Brian and Ryan will be up for re-election for their second 2-year term.

All terms ending June 2028, then up for re-election for a second 2-year term.

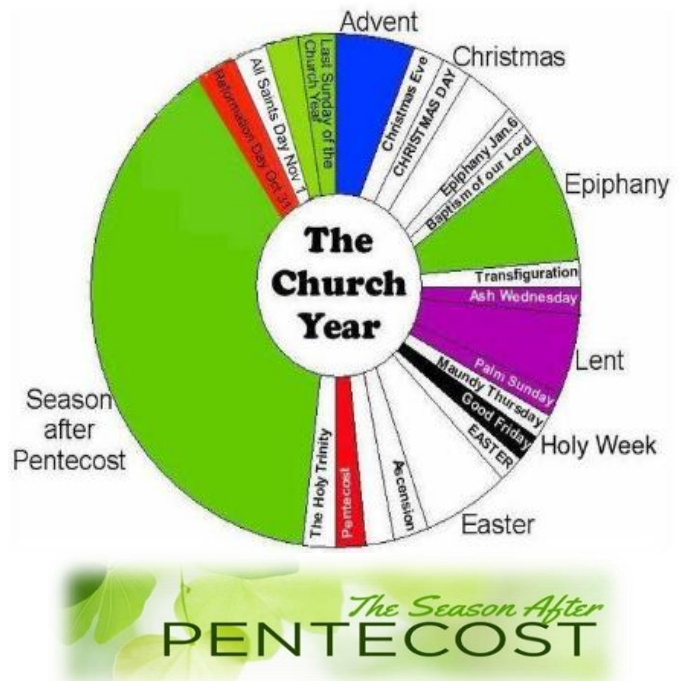
This creates a stagger required by the PoP Bylaws¹. Jack Spencer has been elected as a non-voting supporting elder when available to serve in the winter (Nov-Apr). His first 2-year term ending June 2028. Special thank you to Lee Heup and Brian Hess for their faithful service and continuing as our elected Emeritus elders. Both are non-voting serving as support to the elders, as available.

The transfer of duties began in the June 2026 at the BoE meeting. Elders were **installed**, with other PoP leadership, at the 5-July-2026 early Service.

At the BoE meeting on 14-July-2026, the new team nominated and elected Buck Haney as **Head Elder** to represent them in all Council functions. Jarett MacMaster was nominated and elected as the Recording Secretary, in accordance with the Bylaws. In Christ, Board of Elders

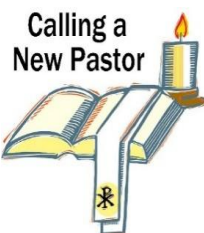

HOLY COMMUNION STATEMENT

In the Sacrament of Holy Communion our Lord Jesus comes to us with **His very body & blood** to eat & to drink **for the forgiveness of sins & to strengthen our union with Him & with one another**. He invites to His table those who trust His words, **repent of all their sin** & forgive & love one another as He forgives & loves us.

Because those who eat & drink our Lord's body & blood unworthily do so to their great harm & because **Holy Communion is a confession of the faith** which is confessed at this altar, any who are not yet instructed or who hold a confession differing from that of this congregation & the LCMS, & yet desire to receive the Sacrament, are asked to **speak with the Pastor before communing**. *For further study, see Matt. 5:23ff, 10:32ff, 18:15-35, 26:26-29; Acts 2:38, 42; 1 Cor. 10:16, 11:17-34.*

Other Christians & children who have not completed instruction may come forward, cross their arms over their chest & receive a blessing. **During distribution, the Individual Cup will be offered first followed by the Common Cup**. For those who prefer it for any reason, the cups in **the center of the tray contain a grape juice option**. Please let the pastor know if you need a **Gluten Free wafer**. Before communing, we ask that first time guests & visitors please speak with the Pastor.
